



The Year of Challenges and Achievements

The year of 2020 was known as the year of Covid 19 pandemic (Coronavirus), which made a strong shock over the world, especially in the economic and social infrastructure. The Association has contributed in confronting the pandemic impact through its social responsibility, where it implemented an exceptional unprecedented plan to ensure the work continuation.

Although that most of 2021 was an extension to the pandemic impact, but Enayah adapted to changes. It was able to launch a group of initiatives and institutional development. It implemented its operational plan efficiently and effectively at the rate of 91%, where it could implement 56 operational goals.

Moreover, Enayah was quick to respond to unplanned qualitative and distinguished opportunities, where it responded to (5) qualitative initiatives in which the Association could utilize them efficiently, resulted in raising the operational performance rate 118%. The qualitative initiatives included a number of strategic partnerships in the sustainability fields, developing Enayah 2030 Vision, studying the impact measurement and sustainability, and in the geographical expansion to include the work abroad via a permit from King Salman Relief Centre.

The year of 2021 is considered an exceptional year regarding the institutional development, whether in building the strategic vision for the next years, or in strategic and operational performance efficiency, or in enhancing the sustainability and corporate communication.




Enayah and Globalism












Volunteering




