A non-profit health Society aiming to enhance the human health and contribute to the health giving in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia through a professional organization.



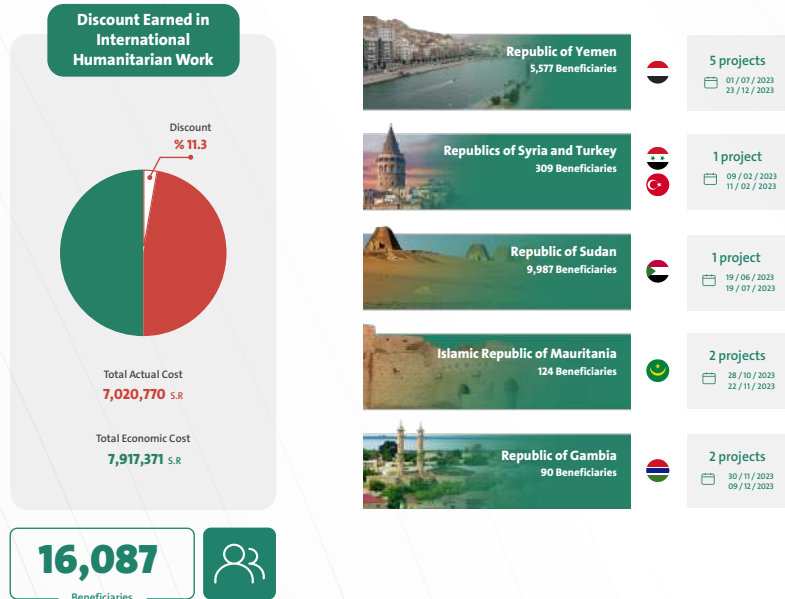
