
Institutional Excellence

the Society, through the Institutional Excellence Department, achieved numerous outstanding accomplishments that reflect its commitment to best practices and international standards.











The role of volunteering programs and health training in prevention







Medical Supply Programs






Project Management




Governance and Transparency
