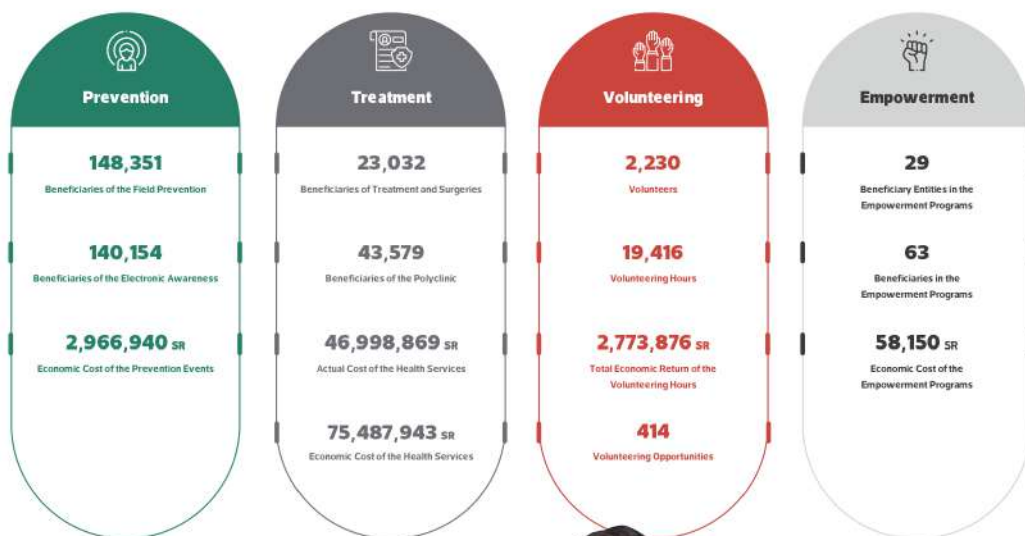

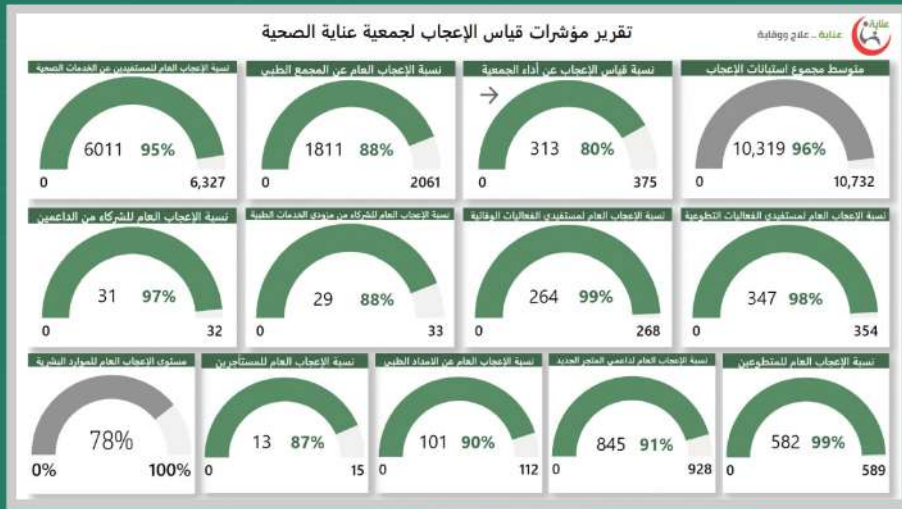
Performance and Strategic Trend in 2022

- The year of 2022 is considered a bridging stage between the first strategic plan (2017-2021) and the second strategic plan (2023-2027).
- At the end of 2021, the Board of Directors approved the strategy of working abroad according to an agreement signed with King Salman Center. Accordingly, the Society has implemented several health services abroad including Jordan, Mauritania and Yemen.
- At the strategic performance level, the completed strategic plan (2017-2022) was closed with an overall performance average of 177%, over the targeted performance.
